TO CELEBRATE BIRDS OF THE DUNELANDS**

JULY 18, 2014 -- "Birds Of The Dunelands" will highlight the next Saugatuck-Douglas Historical Society "Tuesday Talk" on July 29 in the History Center at The Old School House, 130 Center Street, Douglas. The one-hour program begins when the school bell rings at 11 a.m.; admission is free and public attendance is invited.

Presenter Rick Brigham will talk about and show photos of local birds both common and rare, focusing on their relationships to our shoreline, dunes, wetlands and woodlands.

A serious "birder" since youth, Douglas resident Brigham has been a member of the Michigan Bird Records Committee, president of the Capitol Area Audubon Society, and led or participated in many bird counts and surveys in both lower and upper Michigan.
