“MICHIGAN’S HOTTEST TOWN” REVISITED
AT NOV. 12 HISTORICAL SOCIETY PROGRAM

DOUGLAS (MI), OCT. 31, 2014 -- Saugatuck-Douglas Historical Society’s next monthly program on Wednesday, November 12 will look back at our area’s nationally prominent music festivals of the 1960s, starting at 7 p.m. in the Old School House History Center, 130 Center Street, Douglas. Admission is free and public attendance is invited.

Presenter Michael Sampson Sweeney, local artist/musician/writer and founding member of S/DHS, will be documenting the 1959-60-61 Saugatuck Jazz Festivals and 1968-69 Saugatuck Pop Festivals that then spread the community’s fame as “Michigan’s Hottest Town”. These events will be brought to life with music and images, and audience remembrances will be welcomed.
